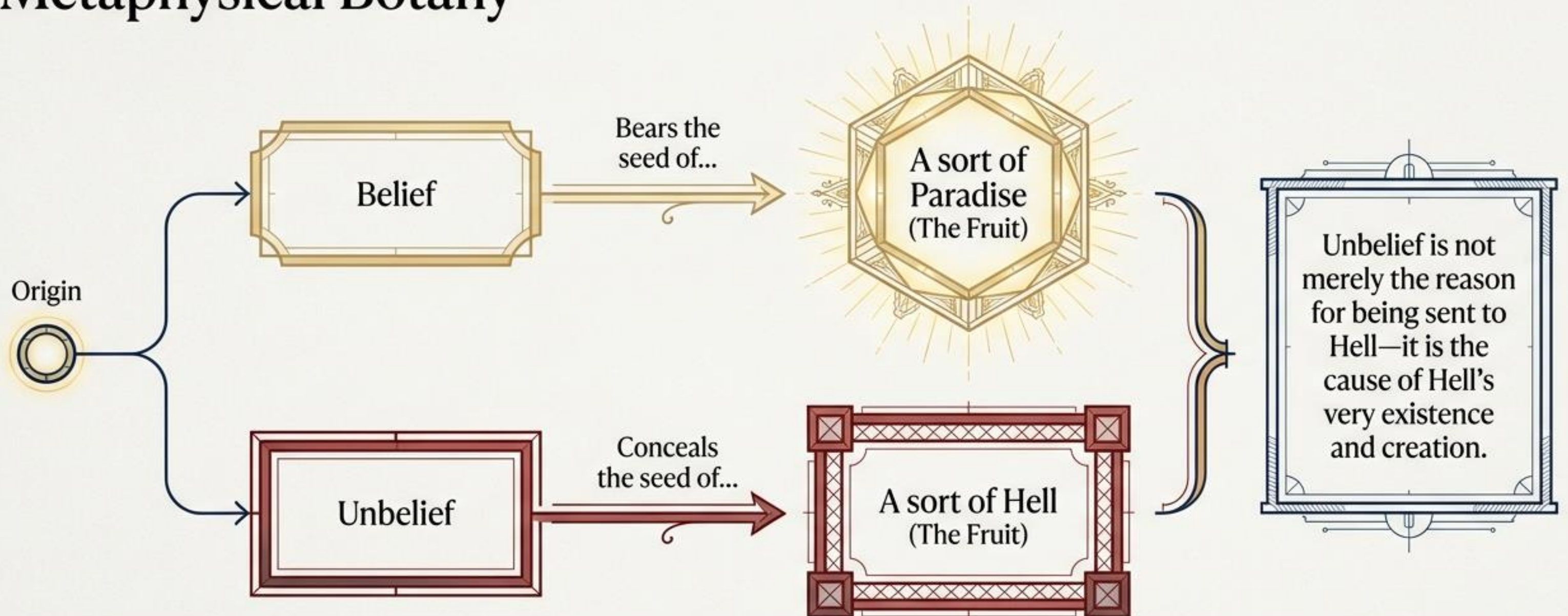

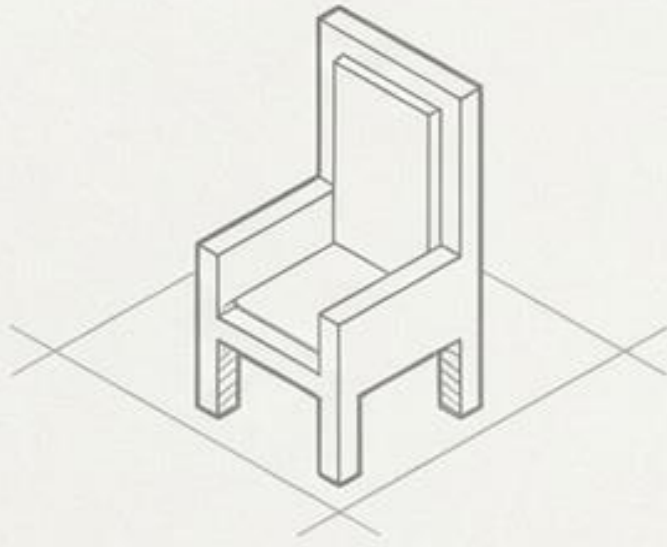

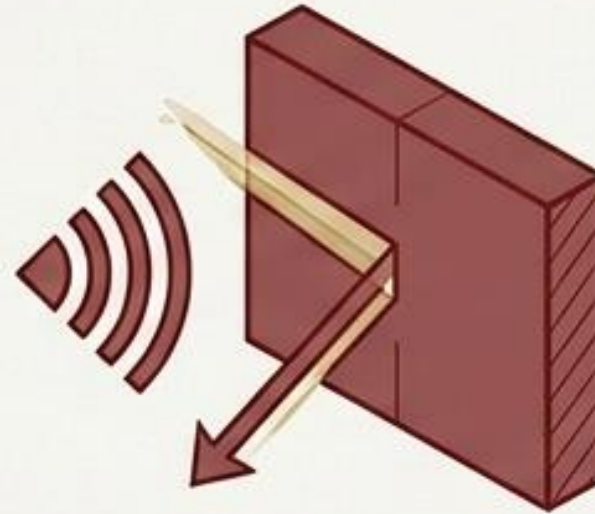
The Mechanics of Authority and Affront

The Context



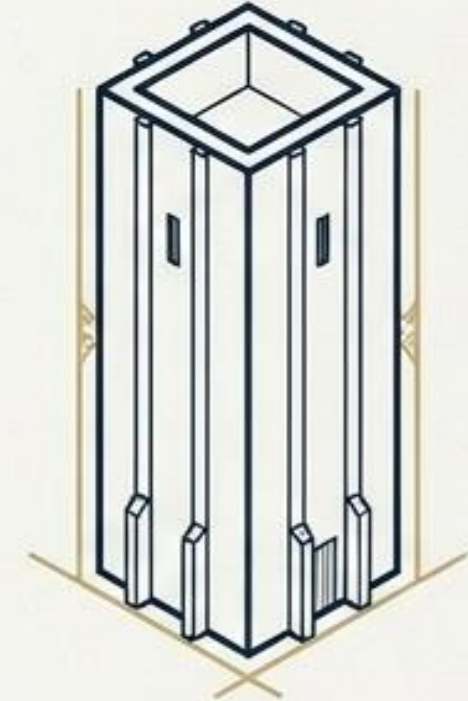
An insignificant ruler of small dignity, small pride, and small majesty.

The Catalyst



The Impudent Claim:
“You may not punish me
and you cannot.”

The Inevitable Reaction



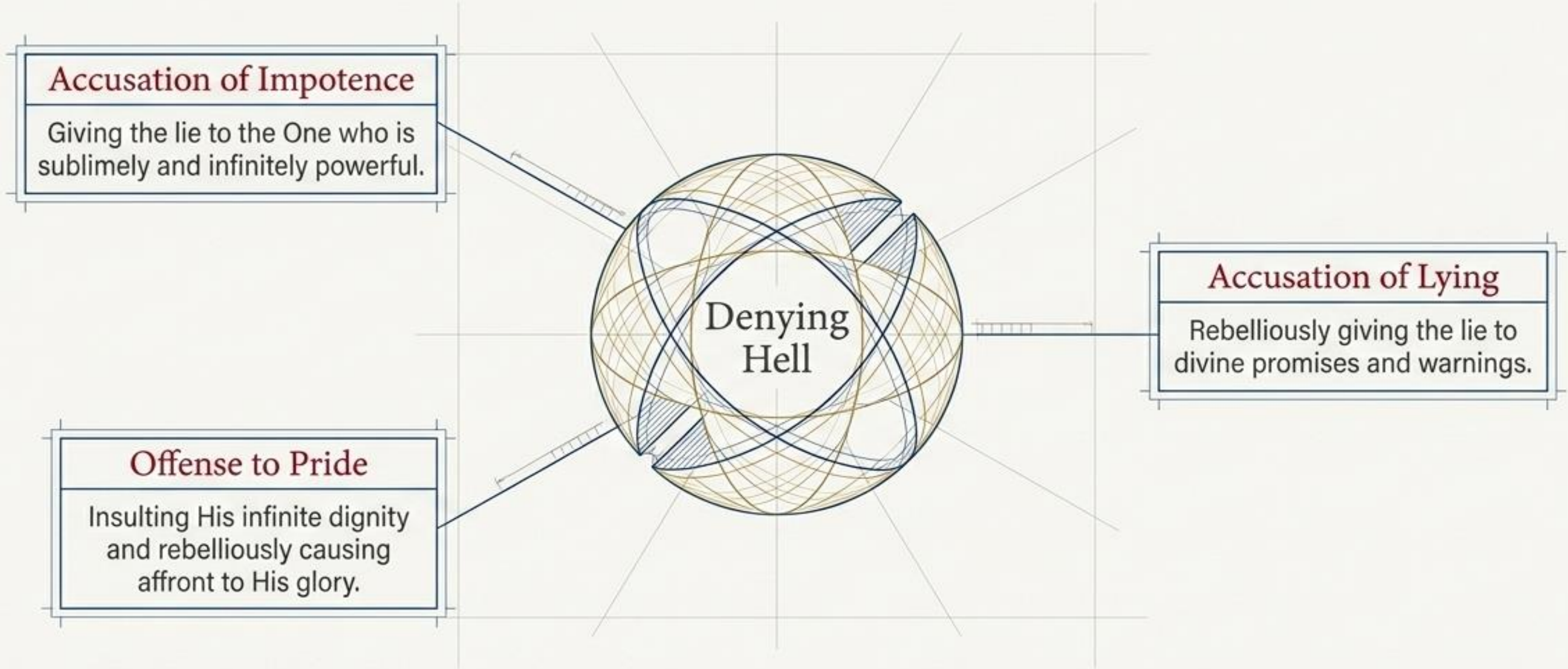
Even if there is no prison in that place, the ruler will certainly have built... and will throw him into it.

Synthesis Insight: A direct challenge to authority demands a demonstration of power, regardless of pre-existing infrastructure.

Scaling Consequence to the Infinite

The Earthly Metaphor		The Metaphysical Reality
Insignificant Ruler (Small dignity and pride)	Authority ○	The Creator (Infinite dignity, pride, and glory)
The Unmannerly Subject	Transgressor ○	The Unbeliever
You cannot punish me.	The Insult ○	Denying the existence of Hell / Ascribing impotence.
Building a local prison to answer the affront.	The Reaction ○	The creation of Hell.

The Anatomy of Denial



If, to suppose the impossible, there were no reason for Hell's existence, it would certainly be created for unbelief, which comprises denial and ascribing impotence to this degree.
